Dear Friends and Supporters:

A dance hall opened next to Bethel Baptist Church. Just two years ago a property next to the church came up for sale for US \$70,000. The church was interested in the purchase of this property. I will admit, though, that my faith was low because the amount of money was high. I did put a note on our website and started to talk to people about the desire to purchase this property.

A year ago, however, the property was purchased by Mr. Oscar, a local dance-hall operator. During the last four months, Mr. Oscar has invested approximately US\$100,000 to convert the property into a bar and dance hall. He was able to get all the permits required by the city and passed all the inspections for public use. Just this past Saturday, November 13, he opened for operation. Mr. Oscar promoted the dance hall on all the local radio stations.

I was there at 11:00 p.m. when it opened for business. I and some people from our church gave a Gospel tract to everybody who showed up to dance. We also gave Gospel tracts to the owner and employees. Over 500 people showed up, and we passed out over 500 Gospel tracts. By 12:30 a.m. you could smell the strong smell of beer in the air outside the church. About a dozen soul winners stayed at the church and had an all-night prayer meeting. At 2:00 the dance hall cranked the rock music up to full volume, and the roof at the church was shaking. We are in shock and do not know what to do. We have faith that God will work everything out for His glory. They plan to open the dance hall every Friday, Saturday, and holidays from 11:00 p.m. to 4:00 a.m. Please pray about this situation.

Many pastors and individuals have asked me about the public-use permit for the church. The church has not passed the city inspection. We need to get the church approved for "public use" and pass the city code. The items that we need to finish for the inspection are the ladies' bathroom, the kitchen, and some of the floors. The items that we have finished are the drop-down ceiling in the auditorium, electrical work all over the church, and the men's bathroom. The people here are giving, but it will take three or four years before we finish. This is heavy on my heart. Please pray that we can pass the city inspection sometime soon.

On Sunday, November 7, we had our annual big day at the church. It is amazing to see what is happening here at the church. On Saturday we had 250 children show up for Sunday school. We just had one bus that made many trips to bring the kids to church and then take them home. Praise the Lord for all the Sunday school teachers and helpers. That night we had 25 show up for the Cry of Hope meeting with 3 first-time visitors. On Sunday morning we had 118 show up for the first time to church. We had 53 saved after the invitation. On Sunday night we had an attendance of 600 people. Over 150 people had to stand up during the entire service because we ran out of chairs.

We praise the Lord for Bethel Baptist Church. Thank you for your support and investment into the work in Argentina. Because of your prayers, hundreds are being saved from the fires of Hell every month.
